

# Canadian Whisky

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We put this list together to match our craft beer list and for you to explore and rejoice in one of Canada's national treasures...

Canadian whisky. Known globally as lighter style whiskies, they are quite different from straight ryes from the States.

They are in fact mostly made from corn and wheat distillates and blended with rye later, giving them that reputation.

Having said that, some of today's distillers have been challenging the traditional classifications attached to Canadian whisky. So drink it neat, on the rocks, or in a cocktail, just be sure to drink this well priced spirit as there's some real gems to be had.

<b>Alberta Premium</b> (Calgary, Alberta) made from 100% rye grain, a complex, serious rye, well balanced with stewed fruit, vanilla, rye spice and a good bite. Great value.	5.25 / 8.50
<b>Alberta Springs 10yr</b> (Calgary, Alberta) a 100% rye whisky that's a little softer, sweeter and a tad more refined than the premium, with good spice and an oaky fudge finish, a grand sipping whisky.	5.25 / 8.50
<b>Black Velvet</b> (Lethbridge, Alberta) a Canadian classic, made from prairie corn and rye, has lighter body, with a rich, caramel, toffee palate, and a short smooth finish.	5.25 / 8.50
<b>Canadian Club</b> (Walkerville/Windsor, Ontario) the flagship 6 year old whisky, with worldwide popularity, has a fresh, soft, nutty nose, light body, vanilla, caramel palate and a clean dry faintly smoky finish.	5.25 / 8.50
<b>Canadian Club Classic 12yr</b> (Walkerville/Windsor, Ontario) higher barley malt percentage than the 6 year old, fuller bodied, creamy whisky with rich butterscotch palate and warm, lingering spicy plum finish.	6 / 9.50
<b>Century Reserve 21yr</b> (High River, Alberta) wonderfully silky, fragrant and complex with a nose of intense cedar, tobacco and honey, a smooth texture and a warm, sweet finish.	8 / 13
<b>Century 'White Owl'</b> (High River, Alberta) new on the market, this original clear whisky has gone through carbon filtration, it has a mild vanilla, honey aroma with some flavour of liquorice and a long clean finish.	7.50 / 12
<b>Corby's Royal Reserve</b> (Toronto, Ontario) sweet vanilla and fruitiness on the nose, a palate of sweet caramel and a little rye grain bite with a mellow oaky finish and a touch of smoke.	5.25 / 8.50
<b>Crown Royal</b> (Gimli, Manitoba) the world's top selling Canadian whisky is a quintessential Canadian, soft and sweet, with a rich toffee aroma, good body, delicately balancing fruit, spice and oak.	6 / 9.50
<b>Crown Royal Special Reserve</b> (Gimli, Manitoba) more intense depth to the crown character, aromas of honey, tea, tropical fruit, with chocolate, nuts and melon, balanced and fragrant, great whisky	9 / 15
<b>Danfield's Private Reserve</b> (Lethbridge, Alberta) a smooth, lighter bodied whisky, elegant nose, notes of fruit, vanilla, honey with touch of coconut and a soft, clean finish.	6 / 9.50
<b>Forty Creek Barrel Select</b> (Grimsby, Ontario) from celebrated Kittling Ridge distillery with base of corn, barley and rye, aromas of honey, vanilla fusing with walnuts, spice, and getle lingering fruity finish.	5.25 / 8.50
<b>Forty Creek Double Barrel Reserve</b> (Grimsby, Ontario) fantastic whisky, golden roasted aroma filled with deep vanilla & toasted pecans, caramelized creaminess in the mouth & an extra long smooth finish.	9 / 15
<b>Gibson's Finest 12yr</b> (Valleyfield, Quebec) a gentle nose with some butter, vanilla and rye grain, dry with a subtle sweetness and slight spiciness, a smooth, light, woody, caramel finish.	5.50 / 9
<b>Gibson's Finest Rare 18yr</b> (Valleyfield, Quebec) rich aroma of classic toffee vanilla with a nice balance of oak and spice with a nice warmth on the palate, a very smooth, flavourful whisky.	8 / 13
<b>Glen Breton Rare 10yr Single Malt</b> (Glenville, Nova Scotia) this Scottish style 100% malted barley is lightly peated with honeysuckle aroma and a butterscotch, marzipan palate with a touch of smoke.	11 / 17
<b>Highwood Centennial 10yr</b> (High River, Alberta) a wheat base giving light, clean, sweet nose, almost rum like, with a smooth peppery taste, caramel notes and a pleasurable finish.	5.25 / 8.50
<b>Hiram Walker Special Old</b> (Walkerville/Windsor, Ontario) toffee, rye and citrus on the nose, aggressive flavour of fruit and spice in the mouth and bold, dry finish.	5.25 / 8.50
<b>Potter's 15yr Plus</b> (Formerly Kelowna, BC now High River, Alberta) hand crafted in small batches, medium bodied with a bit of fruit and hints of chocolate and spice, very smooth.	6.25 / 8.75
<b>Schenley's Golden Wedding</b> (Valleyfield, Quebec) a light bodied 3 year old with a rich, fruity nose of sherry, pears and honey, with a full fruit & vanilla palate and a sweet caramel apple finish.	5.25 / 8.50
<b>Seagram's VO</b> (Formerly Waterloo, Ontario now Gimli, Manitoba) very light whisky with little sweetness, oily body and clean, faintly oaky finish makes this a good entry point to whisky newcomers.	5.25 / 8.50
<b>Tangle Ridge Double Casked</b> (Calgary, Alberta) this 100% rye based whisky, is aged, blended with natural flavours & recasked, has a sherry, vanilla nose, slightly sweet, oaky palate & smooth, mellow finish.	5.25 / 8.50
<b>Wiser's Deluxe</b> (Toronto, Ontario) a 10 year old with soft floral nose and toffee notes, fuller body, rich toasty butterscotch palate and warm, lingering finish of caramel, soft plum and mild spice.	6 / 9.50
<b>Wiser's Small Batch</b> (Toronto, Ontario) distilled in small batches to original 43.4% volume, great flavour of maple and buttery caramel, with honey nut toast and cinnamon in mouth and a long, warm rye finish.	6 / 9.50
<b>Wiser's Very Old 18yr</b> (Toronto, Ontario) a robust, oaky whisky with fresh, dry, floral nose, heavy body, with a rich palate of caramel, apple and spice and a deep, lingering oak finish.	8 / 13
